TOURNAMENT RULES for Wang's Martial Arts Inner-school tournament

I. SCORING FOR FORM

A. A decimal system will be used in scoring form.

8.0 Or 9.0- Forgets Form (NO SECOND CHANCE FOR ADULT BROWN & BLACK)

Beg. divisions (White, Yellow, Orange) - Score from 8.0 to 9.0

(8.0 - 8.2 is poor, 8.3 - 8.5 is fair, 8.6 - 8.8 is good, 8.9 - 9.0 is excellent)

Int. & Adv. Divisions - Score from 9.0 to 10.0

(9.0 - 9.2 is poor, 9.3 - 9.5 is fair, 9.6 - 9.8 is good, 9.9 - 10 is excellent)

B. High and low scores will be eliminated from a contestant's score if five judges are used. If there are three judges no score will be dropped.

C. In case of a tie, below brown belt can run the same form. Advanced belts (brown and black) will be required to run a different form. If competitors tie again, the three judges will point.

II. CRITERIA TO BE CONSIDERED WHEN JUDGING FORM (KATA)

A. Beginner's Form (White/Orange)

1. Basics (Look for correct stances, blocks, strikes)

2. Presentation, Smoothness, Finish

B. Advanced Form (Green to Black)

1. Presentation

2. Difficulty of Form

3. Power

4. Timing

5. Smoothness from movement to movement

6. Application (When scoring Black Belts look for the application of techniques and movements. Flashy does not mean better).

7. Finish

III. SCORING FOR SPARRING (KUMITE)

A. Length of matches

1. All matches will be two running minutes in duration.

2. Time will be stopped when a competitor is injured.

3. Time will be stopped when a competitor has any type of uniform or equipment adjustment.

4. The referee may stop time for an official's conference.

B. Matches ending in a tie will be continued in "Sudden Winning" overtime. This means the next competitor to score a point will be declared the winner.

IV. SCORING SYSTEM

A. Verification of points:

1. The center judge has one vote.

2. The side judges each have one vote.

3. If there are five officials in a match, it will take three votes to verify a point. Three officials need two votes to verify a score.

** The center referee cannot overrule the majority vote.

B. Point evaluation

1. All punching techniques that score, will receive one point.

2. All kicking techniques that score, will receive one point.

3. The first competitor to receive 3 points automatically wins.

4. The competitor who has the most points at the end of time is the winner.

5. If a competitor steps out of the ring (one foot completely out) three times, his opponent receives one point.

C. Fouls - Judges will indicate a foul by pointing a white or red flag to the floor.

1. Minor fouls (3 minor fouls, one point awarded to the opponent.)

a. Stepping out of the ring.

b. Running from an opponent to avoid fight.

2. Major fouls (One point awarded to opponent.)

a. Contact to face.

b. Contact to groin.

c. Illegal techniques (such as knees, eyes, throat, legs and spine.)

V. RULES GOVERNING CONTACT

A. Juniors (5 - 17)

1. All juniors will have no contact to the face or groin.

B. Seniors (18 - 80)

1. All ranks will have no face or groin contact.

VI. EXCESSIVE CONTACT

A. Malicious face, head, body or groin contact will result in disqualification.

B. Swelling or bleeding will result in disqualification

VII. COACHING OF ANY TYPE MAY LEAD TO COMPETITOR BEING DISQUALIFIED.

There will be absolutely no coaching from instructors or others. Let your student win his/her match by themselves.

Tournament & report card point - First place is seven foot trophy.



Report Card Points – Turn in your report cards all year long for a chance to win a seven foot trophy at the Chinese New Year Banquet!

All A's-12pts; A's & B's- 9pts; All B's-6pts; Turn in your report card – 3pts

Tournament Points: Don't forget to turn in your points after each tournament for a chance to win a seven foot trophy at the Chinese New Year Banquet!

1st Place-12pts; 2nd Place-9pts; 3rd Place-6pts; Participation-3pts
